NSF Grant

NSF ART (Track 1) Cross-Institution Commercialization Lab- Build a commercialization infrastructure across local universities, focused on early-stage IP readiness for market.

EDA Grant

EDA Build to Scale Closed-Loop Commercialization & Capital Activation- Expand Market Fit Lab into a full commercialization-to-capital pipeline targeting nationally critical sectors (AI, energy, logistics, cyber).

KNEDA Grant

KY State Grant (KNEDA) Advanced Nuclear & Energy Readiness Clearinghouse- Stand up a statewide readiness platform to prepare KY suppliers and regions to support advanced nuclear and energy projects.
